

## General Information

You may take up to nine units of credit. You may mix and match to tailor make your own program. The courses have been grouped by appropriate grade levels and coded to help. Most courses are one week long and three units.

The courses are strong in content and all offer hands on experiences, ideas, materials and handouts for classroom use. You will have the opportunity to network with highly experienced and relatively new science teachers.

### SCHEDULE

All classes are offered daily, **Monday - Friday, 8 am - 3 pm.**

### CREDIT

All classes are available for credit as noted. Credit is offered in upper division quarter units for professional and supplemental credential use only.

### DEADLINE: MAY 31st 1998

All classes are filled as applications are received. We cannot guarantee positions on the waiting list after this date.

### COSTS

**\$40.00 non refundable application fee, required for all applicants.** This includes parking for up to three weeks. There is no additional cost for parking.

Course fee is **\$250 per 3 units.** Please approach your school and district office for funding via the **Eisenhower Funds.** 1998-99 funds will be available to your district July 1; these are applicable to inservice in math and science.

A number of scholarships for course fees are available through the Science Education Programs Office. Requests may be made upon submission of a completed application form and inclusion of a single page detailing your need for financial support. We regret we have no funding for stipends at this time.

An additional cost is **\$ 60.00 per 3 units of credit,** transcript and credit processing fee (payable during the Institute).
